- Topic: THE FOUR-WAY TEST in the Workplace
- Format: Each contestant shall submit a six-paragraph essay structured as follows:
 - Paragraph 1- Introduction (set forth thesis statement, *i.e.* what the essay will try to demonstrate).
 - Paragraphs 2 through 5 – Address the applicability of each of the four tenets of the **Rotary Four-Way Test Of the things we think, say or do**, which reads as follows:
 - Is it the TRUTH?
 - Is it FAIR to all concerned?
 - Will it build GOOD WILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
 - Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?
 - Paragraph 6 – Conclusion.
- There is no maximum nor minimum number of words required, as long as the above paragraph structure is employed.
- Any type of workplace situation or profession may be considered (*e.g.* Summer Job, Professional Sports, Politics, Education Faculty, Business, *etc.*), and essays may be based on personal experience or be purely theoretical or opinion/editorial in nature.
